The **Toronto Sector Skills Academy** is a 10-month fellowship to help grow and support sector-focused workforce development strategies in the Toronto region. The goal of the Academy is to improve the quantity, quality, and sustainability of sector efforts on the ground.

This is the first Sector Skills Academy to be launched in Canada. Participants in the Toronto Sector Skills Academy will be Aspen Sector Skills Fellows.
