- How did we get here?
 - Four disruptions
 - 1. Pandemic
 - 2. Cultural shifts and search for equity
 - 3. Digital revolution
 - 4. Climate crisis
 - Exacerbation of existing fault lines

STATE OF THE SECTOR

- What are we noticing today?

- 1. Audience return rates and cultural consumption behaviours
- 2. Demographic shifts
- 3. Inflation and the cost of doing business
- 4. Artist and arts worker precarity
- 5. Growing funding gap + redistribution practices
- 6. Understanding and then meeting the cultural needs of people who live in our communities
- 7. Decrease in the purchase on the public imagination
- 8. Decrease in building critical thinking and cultural competence in youth

STATE OF THE SECTOR

How is Metcalf responding?

- 1. Continue to place a significant portion of our resources within arts organizations
- 2. Strategic and hyper-specific opportunities not project, not operational
- 3. In 2024, two new initiatives to meet a more expansive list of needs
 - 1. Booster Fund
 - 2. Strategic Experimentation Fund (SEF)

The Booster Fund amplifies remuneration and access for professional artists and arts workers who participate in existing creation, programming, training, outreach, or education activities and projects offered by performing arts organizations in Toronto

- Single fall deadline: October 2, 2024 by 2pm ET
- Orgs can apply to both Booster and SEF in 2024
- Booster is organizationally framed but exclusively people focused
- Transactional building on an existing baseline for activities or projects planned for **2025**

- Boost existing activity or projects not create something new in all departments: creation, programming, leadership development, training, outreach, or education
- Four ways to boost:
 - 1. Increase remuneration
 - 2. Increase access
 - 3. Reduce **costs** to participate
 - 4. Adding a **new element** up to 20% of total ask

- Additional eligible costs limited amount of non-human
- Ineligible costs not for full or part-time staff
- Funding decision link to mission and success indicators
- Budget envelope (\$240,000) max request (\$30,000)
- Funding less than requested possible tiered approach
- 3 questions only in the application, no budget template
